Why I Chose This Subject

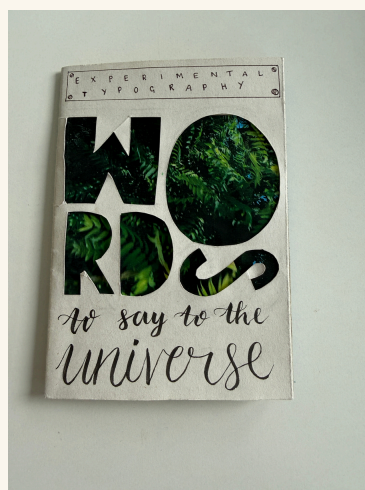
- Your interest in Graphic Communication

Where I'm From

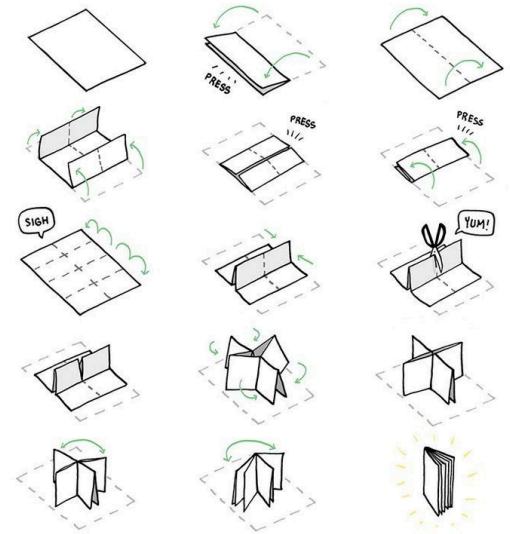
- Your background, identity, or environment
